WHITE SPOT INSPECTOR

FIGURE DRAWING LESSON FOR 1ST GRADE



1. CHARACTERISTICS OF THIS GROUP

This group just finished their shape collage monsters now hanging in the main display case. They haven't had a chance to celebrate their completed pieces yet so we will start off class by going to our online gallery on Artsonia to view them. I will need to remind them that the Hall of Fame Raffle is approaching as well. Today's lesson is based on a Fugleflick video some may have seen in art class while double checking their artwork for white spots.

2. SKILLS, CONCEPTS, AND PURPOSE OF LESSON

Students will be introduced to our figure drawing project based on revealing our own white spot inspector. The story of the white spot inspector will be explained in the Fugleflick video that I will play early on in the lesson. They will begin a step-by-step drawing that will help them correctly proportion their figure with strategies for measuring, drawing with shapes, sketching before adding details, and evaluating choices along the way.

3. TEACHING STRATEGIES AND METHODS

The theme song for this project is the sound track from the White Spot Inspector Fugleflick. I will be running a slideshow of past student art while the Karaoke version of the song plays. I prepared a "fast forward" version of the lesson to show them the entire process so they can understand the big picture. We will watch the video then begin our drawing.
